Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in The Louisville Orchestra! Auditions for Assistant Principal Second Violin (Chair 3) and Section First Violin (Chair 9) will be held over **January 27-29, 2024**. A combined preliminary round will take place on January 27, with final rounds split by position to follow over January 28-29.

These positions are available starting June 1, 2025. The salary for Assistant Principal Second Violin (Chair 3) is \$1,569.46 per week, and the salary for Section First Violin (Chair 9) is \$1,395.08 per week. The 2025-26 Season is 34 weeks. All positions include instrument, life, major medical insurance, and pension. Violin candidates voted qualified may be offered a section violin position if one becomes available within 12 months of the audition. This position can only be offered to applicants with United States citizenship or an appropriate work permit/green card.

Online application, including a 1-page resume, must be submitted no later than 11:59 pm EST on Friday, November 22, 2024. Additionally, a refundable audition deposit of \$100.00 is required from all applicants. The audition deposit must be postmarked no later than Friday, November 22, 2024 for you to participate in the audition.

Briefly, our audition procedures are as follows:

- Resumes may be screened prior to official invitation
- Preliminary, semifinal, and final round auditions occur behind a screen
- The screen may be removed for superfinal round(s)
- You may use your own music, including electronic tablets, during the audition

If you must cancel after receiving an invitation, please do so **prior to close of business (5:00pm EST) on Friday, January 10, 2025**. Checks will be returned only to those candidates who attend the audition, do not receive an official invitation, or cancel their audition prior to this deadline. **All deadlines in the process are final.** Upon receiving your application, resume, and deposit all subsequent correspondence, including official invitation and audition time, will be sent via email.
