Audio Engineer Audition Procedure:

15 August 2024 - Submission deadline for Applicant Fact Sheet & Resume.

15 September 2024 - Applicants must have completed written exam with a recruiter.

15-16 October 2024 - Live audition at Washington Navy Yard - Washington, DC. Invitation Only.

The following steps outline the audition process.

1: All applicants must register with the Auditions Supervisor by e-mailing the Applicant Fact Sheet and one-page resume prior to auditioning. **Audition spots are limited!**

2: A written exam will be required as part of the pre-screen process and will be administered at the applicant's closest Navy Recruiting Office. This must be completed prior to 15 September. **Instructions for this process will be provided *after* you have submitted your applicant fact sheet and resume.** Please do not visit a recruiter prior to receiving these instructions. This step may be completed at anytime prior to 15 September.

3: The written exam will cover live and studio audio production fundamentals, as well as digital audio networking fundamentals. The exam will consist of 45 multiple choice questions and short answer items. Example knowledge topics include:

- Signal Processors
- Acoustics
- Cables and Connectors
- Input Transducers
- IP Addressing
- Digital-to-Analog Conversion
- Ethernet Cabling

- Wireless Networking Standards

4: Applicants who successfully complete the written exam will be invited to a live audition that will consist of two parts: 1.) Troubleshooting 2.) Live Mixing
