#### IMPORTANT NOTICE

The post holder must own their own instrument which should be of a standard suitable for performing professionally.

Eligible for auditions are musicians above 21 years of age. Younger special talent will also be considered. In such case, kindly contact the A.S.O. before applying.

For non- Greek participants, the A.S.O. will provide for a pianist. Greek participants are kindly requested to bring their own pianist.

According to Greek law:

- a. Only EU citizens and Greek diaspora from Albania, Egypt, Cyprus, Istanbul, Gökçeada and Bozcaada, will be considered for this posting.
- b. There is an obligation to submit a degree or diploma from a recognized conservatory or music institution, the latest, after the completion of the 2-year probationary service. A decision will be made at this time for the contract to turn permanent
