- IV. Chamber Music (in Final round): Beethoven, op 59, No 3. 1st mvt. Exposition
- V. <u>Audition by Recording</u>: Candidates whose unavoidable circumstances require them to be a distance of more than three hundred (300) miles from Spokane at the time of the live auditions may submit recordings (without accompaniment) containing the required material, with each excerpt on a separate track with labeling. The recorded audition shall not carry as much musical weight as a live audition. Recordings must reach the Symphony office by August 20, 2025.
