Navy Music needs musicians that are exceptional classical instrumentalists and also those that are exceptional commercial instrumentalists, but you don't need to excel at both! Our auditions are designed to represent a variety of musical styles that you could potentially perform in a Fleet Band.

Prescreens are available but not mandatory. Based on a limited amount of audition slots, a prescreen may be required. Please contact the Auditions Team for prescreen submission details. Backing tracks will be provided with your application confirmation.
