Percussion Audition Procedure:



All applicants must register with the Auditions Supervisor by emailing the applicant fact sheet and onepage resume prior to auditioning. Percussionists auditioning for the Navy Fleet Bands must audition on Drum Set. Please bring with you to your audition: Cymbals, sticks, mallets, your own copies of music, and backing tracks.

Our auditions are designed to represent a variety of musical styles that you could potentially perform in a Fleet Band. All instruments will be provided. A small speaker will be provided for backing tracks.

Prescreens are available but not mandatory. Based on the limited amount of auditions slots, a prescreen may be required. Please contact the Auditions Team for prescreen submission details.

U.S. Navy Fleet Bands

Percussion Audition Procedure:

Percussionists auditioning for U.S. Navy Fleet Bands must perform on **drum set**, **snare drum** and **mallets**.

Percussionists must perform five selections on **drum set** from the following four categories. All **drum set** selections must be performed with backing tracks provided by the applicant.

- 1. Rock (one selection)
- 2. Country (one selection)
- 3. Funk (one selection)
- 4. Jazz (two selections): one swing and one Latin selection

Percussionists must perform two prepared solos and rudiments on snare drum.

1. Concert Snare (one selection)

2. Rudimental Snare (one selection & drum rudiments): in addition to a rudimental solo, percussionists must be prepared to perform the Standard 26 American Drum Rudiments from memory

Percussionists must perform a prepared **mallet** solo.

1. Mallets (one selection)

Optional Solo

1. Timpani (one selection): the applicant may perform an additional selection on timpani
