No. 1 Scherzo – beginning to 16 before [E]

Mozart – Symphony #39

2nd Movement – beginning to measure 28 (no repeats); measures 96-125 (skip measures 109-113)
4th Movement – beginning to measure 78

Prokofiev – Classical Symphony

1st Movement – beginning to measure 85
2nd Movement – beginning to measure 20
4th Movement – beginning to measure 41; measures 127 to 159

Schumann – Symphony No. 2

2nd Movement (Scherzo) - beginning to measure 48 (play repeat); coda

Shostakovich – Symphony No. 5

1st Movement – beginning to 2 after [5]; [32] to 3 after [38]

R. Strauss – Don Juan: Page 1

2nd Movement – solo (beginning to Andantino before [A])
3rd Movement – solo (Lento before [L] to [N])

Haydn – Symphony #103

2nd Movement – measures 85 to 108 (play repeats)

1st Movement – solo (15 after [C] to end)

R. Strauss – Zarathustra

2nd chair solos – 14 measures before [31] to 1 measure before [36]
