Guitar Audition Procedure:



All applicants must register with the Auditions Supervisor by e-mailing the applicant fact sheet and one page resume prior to auditioning. Please bring to the live audition your own copies of music and backing tracks. Our auditions are designed to represent a variety of musical styles that you could potentially perform in a Fleet Band. A small speaker will be provided for backing tracks and a PA speaker with XLR and 1/4" inputs will be provided for instrument amplification. Applicants are encouraged to provide their own amplifiers if possible.

Parking: There are several public parking options within a 5-minute walk to the audition site. Parking at the hotel is valet only and is \$17.50 for 3 hours.

Prescreens are available but not mandatory. Based on a limited amount of audition slots, a prescreen may be required. Please contact the Auditions Team for prescreen submission details.

The audition will consist of the following:

1. *Smooth: Transcribe and perform from the top through the first guitar solo. Source: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QcUxrpIwuQ4

2. Uptown Funk: Transcribe and perform in entirety. Source: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OPf0YbXqDm0

3. Chattahoochie: Transcribe intro, interlude and solo. Comp/fill as needed. Source: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=JW5UEW2kYvc

4. Sir Duke: Transcribe entire tune along with soli. Source: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6sIjSNTS7Fs

5. All the Things You Are: 1 chorus of head, 1 chorus improvisation, 1 chorus comping. Backing track: https://www.youtube.com/watch? v=MopDZu87Dpk&list=PLLERPLaznDt4yxCe7TJHlMWYHuhDC-MxW&index=16

6. Girl From Impanema: 1 chorus of head, 1 chorus improvisation, 1 chorus comping. Backing Track: https://www.youtube.com/watch? v=ytsHANWMspY&list=PLLERPLaznDt4yxCe7TJHlMWYHuhDC-MxW&index=45

7. Solo: Any tune of your choosing.

Sight-reading is required. The applicant will read from a Real/Fake Book and should be prepared to sight-read a blues, swing and Latin selection. The applicant will be asked to play the head, comp the changes, and perform an improvised solo.
