M° FEDELE will evaluate the pieces received. By **June 30th**, after M° FEDELE evaluation, **URTI***canti* will send a confirmation to every admitted participant. The opinion of M° FEDELE will be unquestionable.

By **July 05th**, the registered and admitted participants, have to pay the participation fee of \in 300.00 With the same method as above.

A minimum number of 7 full participants must be reached for the Masterclass to be held.

The selected pieces will be performed during a concert within the program of the **URTI***canti* Festival, 20th edition on September 25, 2025.

Among the actual students of the Masterclass, M° FEDELE will choose a composer who will be invited to participate in the 21st edition of **URTI***canti* in **2026**, with the performance of his own work, to be agreed with the Artistic Direction.

At the end of the Masterclass, a Certificate will be issued to all effective students.

The Masterclass will consist of a presentation by all the effective participants of their aesthetics and their works, also through video and audio supports, and a lesson with M° FEDELE.

A brief presentation of their study curriculum is also required of auditors.

The lessons will also be an opportunity to deepen the work of M° FEDELE through listening and analysis of his scores.

article 7:

Any recordings, radio and/or television broadcasts of the performances during rehearsals or concerts, do not constitute a right for composers and performers to any remuneration.

The Masterclass is part of the 20th edition of the **URTIcanti** contemporary music Festival to be held in Puglia (Italy) in Bari, Cellamare and Monopoli. Effective and Auditor participants will have free access to all the concerts and events organized within the Festival.
