As the November darkness descends and the North Sea flexes its muscles outside the windows, we retreat into the music. We invite you to an exclusive masterclass on the island of Bru, where raw natural forces provide the backdrop for deep artistic exploration. This course is perfect for those who seek to refine their repertoire with professional, individualized feedback; a fresh, International perspective on technique and interpretation and to find new inspiration in the striking nature and the unique "inner calm" of the Stavanger archipelago.

SPANISH CELLIST SALVADOR BOLÓN has served as Associate Principal Cellist of the London Symphony Orchestra since 2024. Previously, he was Principal Cellist of the Orquestra de la Comunitat Valenciana. An alumnus of the Hochschule für Musik Basel, the Reina Sofia School of Music, and Musikene, he has performed as a soloist with orchestras such as the Netherlands Philharmonic and the Basque National Orchestra. A laureate of numerous competitions, including Juventudes Musicales de España and the Primer Palau, he maintains a notable artistic partnership with pianist Benedicte Palko. Deeply committed to education, Salvador has been a professor at the Conservatorio Superior de Música de Aragón since 2025. He frequently coaches youth ensembles, including the Barenboim-Said Foundation and the Spanish National Youth Orchestra, and serves as a mentor for the LSO's "String Experience" and the Guildhall School. Additionally, he has been the founder and artistic director of the Calderona de Serra Chamber Music Festival since 2021. Salvador performs on an 1811 Vincenzo Panormo cello, on loan from the London Symphony Orchestra. PIANIST BENEDICTE PALKO is the artistic director of PALKO & Co. Born and raised in Stavanger, Benedicte has had a permanent residence in Seville, Spain since 2002. Benedicte possesses a unique ability to communicate and quickly connect with students, regardless of instrument or ensemble. This is built upon a profound love for music, extensive international experience and documented success with students ranging from young talents to master's level, as well as frequent masterclasses at renowned institutions such as Mozarteum and Korea University of Arts. She offers a holistic pedagogical approach with a particular focus on profound score and musical understanding. Her approach is shaped by, and draws upon a unique combination of Hungarian, German and Spanish musical traditions. In addition to her regular work at MUSIKENE, Benedicte is frequently invited to lead masterclasses in Spain, the rest of Europe, and Asia. She also opens her home to young, professional musicians and ensembles from Spain and abroad, meticulously preparing them for concerts, competitions, recordings, and more.
