AIA – Austrian Imperial Arts e.U. organizes a concert series to present the new conductors and composers on stage with outstanding professional European symphony orchestras.

AIM

AIA wants to support the special upcoming talents, who could be the future stars as leading personalities in the music life.

With this goal in mind, we are looking for:

1. Conductors who are one step before their career,
2. Conductors with experience, who want to join AIA's idea and present themselves to the world,
3. Special talents without academic conducting education, but with a great personality as a conductor,
4. Soloists with great musical abilities, who want to conduct a professional European symphony orchestra,
5. Composers who want to perform their own pieces, conducted by themselves or by an experienced professional conductor.



PROGRAM

In this special project, AIA will organize a complete supporting program for the chosen participants, with 2 days of preparation before the first rehearsal, 3 days of rehearsals with professional symphony orchestra and 3 times of seminars with discussion and analysis of the rehearsal video.

During this working week we will also organize dialogues and discussions with selected personalities.

There will be 1 general rehearsal and 1 concert in the residence concert hall of the symphony orchestra, the concert will be *live-recorded* on video with 3 cameras.

REWARDS

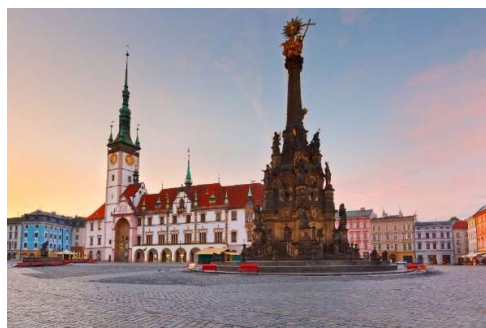
After the successful concert, the participants will receive a certificate and a recommendation letter from AIA Vienna. a recommendation from the orchestra manager and the artistic director of this project.

AIA will also choose some conductors for further cooperation in future projects in Europe and Asia. If you are chosen by AIA (or another cooperation agent) you will be offered a 2-years contract.

I. Stravinsky	“Firebird” (selected movements)

You should choose 1 piece from the list above for your concert performance with video recording. Of course, you could also choose a second or even third piece for your own studying and training purpose. But be aware that you reserve enough time for your concert recording piece, to reach the best possible quality.

We suggest all conductors to study as many pieces of the list as you can, because even you do not conduct all of them, but through the seminars, discussions and watching others' rehearsal you could learn a lot and prepare for your next opportunity.

If you have any special program wish for example your own composition, just write to us! It should be less than 9 minutes, written in the traditional way, and possible for you and the orchestra to prepare within 3 short rehearsals to reach the concert and recording level! We will discuss your suggestion with the artistic director of this project and with the orchestra manager, and we will answer you.
