Mr. Kosower has worked with students in lessons and master classes around the world including the New World Symphony fellows, the Shanghai Orchestra Academy, and the Baccareli Institute in São Paulo. Mark Kosower's previous posts include Conservatory Faculty at the Cleveland Institute of Music from 2010-19, Solo Cellist of the Bamberg Symphony Orchestra in Germany from 2006 - 2010, and Professor of Cello and Chamber Music at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music from 2005 - 2007.
