# Tutti strings, winds, keyboard, harp & percussion players

**Musical level** 

Winds and percussion minimum 1er Prix (or equivalent level)
Strings minimum 2e Prix (or equivalent level)

Non-resident musicians currently studying or having completed Bachelor of Music or Master of Music

**Common language** English (rehearsals are in English)

Age limit 30 years old

Minimum age for resident musicians /
Minimum age for non-resident musicians 18

### **Application**

Video Requirements - 2 videos

- 2 pieces of different styles, ideally one of which from the classical period

- solo or with accompaniment

- if you want to send a chamber music or orchestra video, we ask you to send it as a 3rd video

- length: min. 2 min per piece (no maximum length)

each piece should be recorded in one take, without being edited
 format: YouTube link only, preferably 2 separate videos/links
 make sure the visibility is set to "unlisted" or "public"

- if you've played with ONJ before, please feel free to send the same video again

Age limit 30 years old

Minimum age for resident musicians /
Minimum age for non-resident musicians 18

Video Requirements - 2 videos

- 2 pieces of different styles, ideally one of which from the classical period

- solo or with accompaniment

- if you want to send a chamber music or orchestra video, we ask you to send it as a 3rd video

- length: min. 5 min per piece (no maximum length)

- each piece should be recorded in one take, without being edited

- format: YouTube link, either everything in one video/link or in separate videos/links

### **Accommodation**

The ONJ provides:

- accommodation in a youth hostel or boarding house for non-resident musician
- per diem, if applicable

### **Travel Costs**

The ONJ can help you with your travel costs only if the tickets have been booked in agreement with the organization team, and up to a maximum of:

- 300€ if the ticket is booked within 2 weeks of confirmation of participation ("earlybird")
- 200€ if the ticket is booked later than 2 weeks after confirmation of participation

Public transport in Luxembourg is free of charge.
