Curriculum vitae (CV) with a photo

Reference letter from a professional musician of repute

The video link and registration form must be submitted no later than one month before the Menuhin Academy Spring Masterclasses.

Instruments : violin, viola, cello.

Minimum video requirements:

- a) Two contrasting movements from any one of Bach's Solo Sonatas and Partitas
OR Bach's Suites for Solo Cello
- b) One movement from a major concerto

Candidates are responsible for their own travel arrangements.
