As part of the application, we require a performance video of you, which may include multiple pieces, to be sent to info@opusone.studio. From this video, we will select one or two pieces for the masterclasses with the professors. These selected pieces will also be performed at the Royal Academy of Music on August 9th. The remaining repertoire can be performed at other festival events, such as the public concert at St Mary LeStrand Church on August 4th and/or the private performance at the Clock Tower on August 5th.

The submitted video will also be used to assess chamber music placement. Instrumentalists and vocalists will be paired with pianists and assigned duo repertoire based on skill level to ensure a well-balanced collaboration. Chamber music pieces will be assigned two weeks after registration is confirmed, allowing ample time for preparation.

Who can apply

The festival welcomes music students of all levels, advanced amateur musicians, and music teachers who wish to connect, refresh their skills, and network.

Dates:

- Registration opening: February 20th 2025
- Registration closing: June 15th 2025
- Exact date of masterclasses will be confirmed in July 2025

Note:

Upon request, we can arrange additional one-on-one masterclass at the Royal Academy of Music for an extra fee.

All accompanying parents and teachers are welcomed to attend and observe all classes and concerts at no additional cost, subject to availability.

DEPOSIT & PAYMENT TERMS

1. Deposit Requirement:

• The participant must pay OPUS ONE a 50% deposit per student within 14 days of registration.

REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY

1. Student Withdrawals

- More than 60 days before the festival: Full refund minus a £100 admin fee.
- Between 30 60 days before the festival: 50% refund of the full package price.
- Less than 30 days before the festival: No refund.

2. If OPUS ONE Cancels (Festival Cancellation)

Full refund of all payments made, or option to roll over the booking to the next festival.

3. Force Majeure (Unforeseeable Events)

 If cancellations are due to unforeseen government restrictions, travel bans, or extreme circumstances, both parties may negotiate a partial refund or credit towards a future event.

SCOPE OF RESPONSIBILITY

1. Minors under the age of 18 at the start of the festival must be accompanied by a parent.

2. OPUS ONE is not responsible for the following matters, which must be arranged by the student:

- International flights, visa applications, and related costs.
- Local transportation (e.g., airport transfers, city travel, etc.).
- Personal insurance (including but not limited to travel and health insurance).
- Personal meals, shopping, and any activities not arranged by the festival.
