Accompanying pianist:

The course will have an accompanying pianist to support selected students performing in the student concert and during individual classes.

For better class organization, it is necessary to send along with the rest of the registration documentation the piano part of the piece the student wishes to work on in class. The chosen program cannot be modified once the registration has been submitted.

Student Concert:

The teachers will make a selection among the course students to perform the program that will be interpreted in this concert on Saturday, July 27th at 8:00 PM.

Diploma:

A diploma will be awarded to all attending students at the student concert on Saturday, July 27th.

Closing Concert of the Festival:

It will take place on **Sunday, July 28th** at Teatro Leal in La Laguna at 7:00 PM, where the winner of the I Soloist Competition will perform as a soloist alongside the Aguere Chamber Orchestra, interpreting:

Registration:

I INTERNATIONAL SOLOIST COMPETITION

GUIDELINES

In this edition, the I Soloist Competition of the Aguere International Music Festival is aimed at **saxophonists** of any nationality up to 30 years of age (participants must not have turned 31 before the registration deadline). Registration in the competition implies full acceptance of the guidelines and consent to the processing of data, images, and videos provided by the applicants.

The registration period is from April 5th, 2024, to May 31st, 2024.

The registration fee to participate is €40.00.

Unless due to a duly justified force majeure, the registration fee will not be refunded.

Participants enrolled in the Saxophone Improvement Course of the II Aguere International Music Festival who wish to participate as contestants in this I Soloist Competition do not need to pay a registration fee to enter the competition.

The decisions of the jury are final and cannot be appealed.

ROUNDS AND REPERTOIRE:

The competition, designed to select the soloist who will perform with the **Aguere Chamber Orchestra** at the closing concert of the Festival, will consist of two phases:

- 1. First Round (online)
- 2. Second Round (in-person)

1. First Round (online)

In this first phase, a preselection will be made via video submission. Requested program for the recording:

Free repertoire (between 5 and 10 minutes)

The accompanying pianist for the video recording requested in the first phase is the responsibility of the participant (if the chosen repertoire requires it).

Video conditions:

- The video must have no cuts or edits.
- It must have good quality image and audio for evaluation.
- It must be a recent recording.
- The shot must be frontal, and the camera for recording must be positioned so that the contestant is visible in full body at all times.

Results:

Once all the videos from the contestants have been received, the Festival organization and the jury will select a total of eight contestants to advance to the second phase (in-person phase).

Results will be published on the Festival's social media and website before June 15, 2024.

The eight contestants selected to advance to the second phase will also be notified by email. They will have two business days from the notification of the result to confirm their attendance to the Festival organization for the second round.

2. Second Round (live)

The contestants selected in the first phase must appear on Friday, July 26th at 9:00 AM at the Guillermo González Music School in San Cristóbal de La Laguna

In this phase, the selected contestants must perform:

Jacques Ibert (1890-1962)

Concertino da camera for alto saxophone and orchestra (1935)

I. Allegro con moto

A draw will be conducted before starting to determine the performance order of the contestants.

The organization provides an accompanying pianist for second round. If the contestant prefers to perform with their own pianist, the expenses are borne by the contestant.

Travel, subsistence, and accommodation expenses during the in-person phase are the responsibility of the contestants.

Results of the second round:

After listening to the eight finalists, the jury will select the soloist who will perform with the **Aguere Chamber Orchestra** at the closing concert of the II Aguere International Music Festival.

If deemed appropriate by the jury, second and third prizes may be awarded as reserve soloists.

The program that the winning soloist will perform at the closing concert will be:

Jacques Ibert (1890-1962)

Concertino da camera for alto saxophone and orchestra (1935)

I. Allegro con moto

II. Larghetto - Animato molto

To prepare for the closing concert, rehearsals with the orchestra will take place on Friday, July 26th, and Saturday, July 27th. The organization will take care of logistical needs for transportation if necessary.

Prizes:

The prizes for the winning soloist of the in-person phase are:

- Concert as a soloist with the Aguere Chamber Orchestra at the Closing Concert of the Festival to be held on Sunday, July 28th, 2024, at Teatro Leal de La Laguna at 7:00 PM.
- Professional video recording of the concert.
- Travel allowance of €100.00
- Awarded a recital within the programming of the Aguere International Music Festival in the following 2025 edition. Fee of €1,000.00 (gross)

If second and third prizes are awarded as reserve soloists, the contestant(s) will receive:

- Travel allowance of €100.00 each

Requirements for registration submissions:

To register, contestants must fill out the online registration form available on the Festival's website and social media, attaching the following documentation:

- ID of the contestant
- Recording link
- Artistic biography
- Bank receipt of the registration fee payment*

*Active students in the saxophone improvement course of the Festival participating in the soloist competition do not need to pay a registration fee for the competition. Instead, they must indicate it in the competition registration and present alongside it the bank receipt for the improvement course registration.
