The Competition

The Competition aims to promote musical culture and encourage young people to study music both in solo and chamber settings. The 3rd International Clarinet Competition "City of Vallo della Lucania" Special Prize "Aniello De Vita" is open to all young Italian and foreign musicians. We believe that valuing the study of music is an investment in culture, creating networks, and fostering knowledge—all within the splendid setting of Cilento, one of Italy's most beautiful regions.

Regulations

Art. 1

The "R. Goitre" Music Institute, in collaboration with the Municipality of Vallo della Lucania (Sa), the Department of Culture, the Diocese of Vallo della Lucania, and the Cilento, Vallo di Diano, and Alburni National Park Authority, announces the 3rd edition of the International Clarinet Competition "Special Prize Aniello De Vita," which will be held from April 26 to April 30, 2025, in Vallo della Lucania - SA (Italy) at the Palazzo della Cultura (former Dominican Convent) on Via Mons. Nicodemo 2/4 and at the Cineteatro "La Provvidenza" on Via Valenzani, 84078 Vallo della Lucania.

Art. 2

The Competition is open to young clarinetists and is divided into four sections:

JUNIOR SOLOISTS "A" (born after 01/01/2009 and no later than 12/31/2011)

Program:

- Performance of a freely chosen program lasting a maximum of 15 minutes. Only original compositions are allowed. The selected pieces must be indicated on the registration form.

JUNIOR SOLOISTS "B" (born after 01/01/2005 and no later than 12/31/2008)

Program:

Preliminary Round Performance of the following pieces:

- C.M. von Weber Concertino op.26 for Clarinet and Orchestra
- E. Cavallini 30 Caprices for Clarinet No. 23

Final Round Performance of the following piece:

- J. Stamitz Concerto in B-flat Major for Clarinet and Orchestra



SENIOR SOLOISTS (born after 01/01/1995)

Program:

Preliminary Round

- Carl Maria von Weber Concerto No. 2 in E-flat Major Op. 74 for Clarinet and Orchestra (only first movement)

Semifinal Round

- Performance of one of the following pieces for Clarinet and Piano:
 - C. Debussy Premiere Rhapsodie for Clarinet and Piano
 - R. Schumann Fantasy Pieces op. 73 for Clarinet and Piano
 - F. Poulenc Sonata for Clarinet and Piano
 - M. Arnold Sonatina for Clarinet and Piano
 - B. Martinu Sonatina for Clarinet and Piano
- Performance of one of the following pieces for Clarinet Solo:
 - I. Stravinsky Three Pieces for Clarinet Solo
 - J. Widmann Fantasie for Clarinet Solo
 - G. Miluccio Rhapsodie for Clarinet Solo
 - E. Denisov Sonata for Clarinet in B-flat
 - V. Bucchi Concerto for Clarinet Solo
- Performance of one of the following pieces for Clarinet and Piano:
 - D. Lovreglio Concert Fantasy for Clarinet and Piano based on themes from "La Traviata" by G. Verdi
 - L. Bassi Concert Fantasy for Clarinet and Piano based on themes from "Rigoletto" by G. Verdi

Final Round

- Performance with string quartet of the following piece:
 - W.A. Mozart Quintet in A Major K581 for Clarinet in A and String Quartet

- N.H. Samale Prelude, Scherzo, and Finale for Clarinet Solo (available for purchase on Edizioni Musicali Eufonia’s website)

Art. 3

Registration for the competition implies acceptance of all the rules in the regulations, as well as any changes made by the artistic and organizational direction.

Art. 4

Registration fees:

- €70.00 for JUNIOR SOLOISTS “A” and “B”
- €100.00 for SENIOR SOLOISTS
- €60.00 for the SPECIAL PRIZE section
- Accompanist pianist fee: €60.00 (see Art. 6)

Registration fees will only be refunded under the conditions set out in Art. 22.

Art. 5

Competitors must bring original sheet music. Junior "A" category candidates must send the scores of their freely chosen pieces to the competition secretariat within the registration deadline. All pieces must be performed in their original form; no simplifications or transcriptions are allowed. Absolute first-prize winners in each category may not compete in the same category the following year.

Art. 6

Candidates may use an accompanist pianist. They may bring their own pianist or request one provided by the organization by mentioning it on the registration form and paying the accompanying pianist fee. The piano rooms are exclusively for competition pianists; no other candidates may use them for rehearsals. Personal pianists may rehearse alone for up to 15 minutes upon prior reservation.



Art. 7

Late applications may be accepted at the discretion of the competition management. Candidates may participate in multiple sections, a higher category than their age group allows, but not a lower one.

Art. 8

All candidates upon their arrival in Vallo della Lucania may inquire about the scheduled time of their audition at the Competition Secretariat at Via Mons. Nicodemo 2/4.

Art. 9

Competitors must present themselves for the tests in good time, with a valid identity document. Latecomers will be excluded from the competition and may be readmitted, at the sole discretion of the Commission, only if the delay is justified by serious and documented reasons, provided that the tests related to the section or category of the late competitor have not yet been completed. The auditions will be public.

Art. 10

The schedules for the tests and auditions will be published on the competition website starting from April 10, 2025. Competitors may inquire about this at the competition secretariat from that date onward.

Art. 11

Travel, food, and accommodation expenses are the responsibility of the candidates. Information on hotels and restaurants affiliated with the event will be available on the institute's website and at the competition secretariat.

Art. 12

The judging panel will consist of prominent figures from the international scene. The members of the judging panel will abstain from evaluating participants with whom they have had teaching relations in the two previous years. The panel may interrupt the performances or ask for them to be repeated if deemed necessary. The competitor may, provided the panel does not interrupt, continue the performance beyond the maximum time limits for single-unit compositions, as long as it is a reasonable excess.



Art. 13

The members of the judging panel will express their evaluation for each competitor. In the "Senior" Solo Clarinet category, semi-final phase, a maximum of 15 competitors will be admitted, provided their score is no less than 75/100. In the "Senior" and "Junior B" categories, a maximum of 6 competitors will reach the final, provided their score is no less than 85/100. The score of each competitor will be the arithmetic average of the votes given by each member of the Commission, after deducting the highest and lowest scores. The results will be announced to the participants at the end of the auditions for the entire category. If, for any reason, a member of the judging panel is absent or does not show up, their place will be taken by the Artistic Director.

Art. 14

The judging panel may, at its sole discretion, decide not to award any prizes if the artistic level of the candidates is deemed insufficient; in any case, the panel's decision is final and non-appellable.

Art. 16

The award ceremony, tests, and final phase for the Senior category will take place at the "La Provvidenza" Cinema Theatre, located at Via Valenzani in Vallo della Lucania, on Tuesday, April 30, 2025, at 8:30 PM. Winners may collect their prizes exclusively during this final evening. Competitors who have been awarded prizes but are not present at the award ceremony will forfeit their prizes.

Art. 17

The organization reserves the right to cancel the competition for categories where the number of registered participants is insufficient. In such cases, the registration fees will be refunded.

Art. 18

All rights to any audiovisual, photographic, and radio recordings are reserved by the competition organizers, and no compensation can be requested for such recordings. During the auditions and the award concert, both audiovisual and photographic recordings are prohibited.
