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2025

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INTRODUCTION

The Vice-Chancellor for Culture and Society of the University of Almería are organizing the 5th International Orchestral Conducting Competition with its final stages to be held from October 9th to 13th, 2025 in Almería.

This competition, now in its fifth year, has established itself as a platform for young conductors worldwide. The winners of this competition have gone on to conduct concerts as principal or guest conductors in prestigious orchestras in cities such as Hamburg, Berlin, and Philadelphia, among many others.

1. PARTICIPANT'S PROFILE

Conductors of all nationalities are welcome to participate as long as they are over 18 years old and under the age of 35 (by the end of the registration period, 20th May 2025).

The winners of the two previous editions will not be able to present themselves to this edition.

2. REGISTRATION

Registrations should be made by filling in the form available under the following link: **INSCRIPTION**, in which you will be asked to submit your personal information and your CV. The following information must be included in the form:

- > Musical studies completed, including both formal and informal training.
- > Musical studies in the field of conducting, including both formal and informal training.
- > Professional experience in the field of conducting
- > One or more letters of recommendation may be attached from prestigious conductors.

The judging panel may request, if deemed necessary, accreditation of the qualifications presented by any of the candidates.

This form may be completed either in English or in Spanish. The registration period will begin on the **15th of April and will end on the 20th of May 2025**.

The registration fee will be \in 50. This fee will be paid following the steps in the registration form.



3. PRELIMINARY SELECTION PROCESS

On the 1st of June 2025, the provisional list of selected conductors will be sent by email to the candidates. Applicants will have a period of 10 calendar days for any possible appeal.

The final list of the selected conductors will be emailed to the candidates on the 15th of June.

4. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

4.1. First Round - Online Format

Between 15th -30th of Juny, all the candidates who have been selected should send a video through a link that will be provided by the University. The video must contain the following information:

> The conductor must appear presenting themself to the camera and showing their ID.

> Verification-using a programme handout or a video presentation-that the recording has been made within the time period: 30th of Juny of 2023 to 30th June of 2025.

> In the video, the candidate will conduct an orchestra or band ensemble (formed by a minimum of 8 instrumentalists). The conductor may present one or more musical pieces for a minimum duration of 10 minutes.

> The video must be in Mp4 format or similar and be of sufficient quality for the judges to assess the conductor. In the video, the conductor's face or profile must appear in at least 50% of the shots.

Once all of the videos have been assessed, the jury will publish on the 15th of July the scores for the first round. The participants will be informed via email of the results.

The eight candidates with the highest score will pass onto the second round of the competition.

4.2. Second Round - In-person Format

The selected candidates must be present on the 9th of October at 19:00 in the University of Almería. At this event, the order of participants' appearance and the pieces that each participant will have to conduct will be randomly established through a public draw which will be held amongst the candidates. On the 10th of October the competition will take place. It will consist of conducting one of the following pieces which will be randomly assigned to the participants:



Serenade in C minor K388 W.A.Mozart (OUAL's wind ensemble) Divertimento in D, KV 136 (125a) W. A. Mozart (OUAL's string ensemble)

Once the performances have been assessed, the judging panel will publish the results of the second round.

The four finalists will advance to the third round. In no case there can be a tie between the 4th and the 5th candidate. In the event of a tie, the judging panel will decide by vote which candidate goes to the 3rd round.

Following the announcement of the finalists, there will be a public draw to establish the order of appearance and the musical pieces to be conducted during the third round.

4.3. Third round. In-person Format

The third round will consist of two parts:

First part

On the 12th of October, the finalists will have a one hour and a fifteen rehearsal with the University of Almeria's Orchestra and Belén Roig (soprano). The time slots for the rehearsal will be randomly allocated and the rehearsal will be an opportunity for the finalists to arrange one of the following blocks of repertoire:

Block 1 Symphony nº7 (I movement) Porgi amor (Le nozze di Figaro)	A. Dvorak W. A. Mozart
Block 2 Symphony nº7 (II movement) Da tempeste (Giulio Cesare in Egitto)	A. Dvorak G. F. Haendel
<mark>Block 3</mark> Symphony n°7 (III movement) Kommt ein schlanker Bursch gegangen (Der Freischütz)	A. Dvorak C. M. von Weber
<mark>Block 4</mark> Symphony nº7 (IV movement) Si, mi chiamano Mimì (La Bohème)	A. Dvorak G. Puccini



Second part

The finalists will conduct their repertoire blocks at the final concert which will be held on the October 13th at 12:00pm. This concert will take place in the Auditorio Maestro Padilla, Almería.

At the end of the performance, the judging panel's decision will be made public.

5. AWARDS AND JURY

> 1st Prize. Consisting of an accreditation certificate and 4,000 euros.

1 Concert as a guest conductor with the Orchestra Cittá Metropolitana Di Bari (Italy).

1 Concert as a guest conductor with the Pitesti Symphony Orchestra (Romania)

1 Concert as a guest conductor with the Kalisz Philharmonic Orchestra (Poland)

> 2nd Prize. Consisting of an accreditation certificate and 1,000 euros.

> Orchestra Award - Consisting of an accreditation certificate (to be decided by a vote of the orchestra musicians at the end of the concert/competition).

The judging panel's decision and the musicians' vote will not be open to appeal. Once the competition is over, the organization will send the four finalists a copy of the final record.

The jury will be composed of the Vice-Rector for Culture and Society of the University of Almería as President, the Director of the Secretariat of Culture of the University of Almería as Secretary, and three internationally renowned orchestra conductors, whose names will be announced at a press conference once the registration period has closed.

6. ACCOMMODATION

The organizers will cover accommodation for the finalists in the second and third rounds, as well as dinner on October 9th and lunch on October 12th.

7. MODIFICATIONS

The organization may modify the number of participants in the different rounds as well as make any changes it deems necessary for the proper functioning of the competition.



8. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

Participation in the competition implies a complete acceptance of the rules and conditions, as well as the express compliance of the participants to them; this includes any decisions made by the judging panel regarding the rules for resolving any doubt or conflict that might arise.

9. DATA PROTECTION

The personal data provided by the interested parties will be processed by the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Almería to manage the outreach assistance call in accordance with the provisions laid down in EU Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and the Council on 27th April 2016 concerning the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, repealing Directive 95/46/EC and Organic Law 3/2018 of 5th December on Data Protection and the Guarantee of Digital Rights. We inform you that the personal data provided, as a natural person, or in the case of a person's legal representative, will be processed by the person responsible at the UNIVERSITY OF ALMERIA.

The data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfill the purpose for which they were collected and to determine the possible responsibilities that could arise from that purpose and the processing of the data.
