Repertoire Guidelines - No fixed repertoire. Any piano concerto may be proposed. - However, some works may not be accepted due to venue and orchestral limitations (e.g. Ravel 1st mov. excluded, overly large percussion sections, availability of scores, etc.). - Final approval of repertoire will be determined after jury consultation. - The performance time and fee will be based on the PTNA Piano Encyclopedia's listed duration. - Memorization is not required. - If the piece includes a cadenza, it must be performed. The cadenza may be original or chosen freely.

Evaluation - 3 jurors; each awards up to 20 points (total score: 60 points). - Scores and written feedback will be sent to each participant individually. - Results will be announced at the venue and also published online.

Prizes - Prizes awarded to the top 3 performers (1st–3rd Prize). - Winners will receive a certificate and commemorative gift. - Orchestra Prize awarded by vote of the orchestra members.
